Local Food Recycling and Regenerative Opportunities Act

In May 2025, Representatives Marilyn Strickland (D-WA) and Dan Newhouse (R-WA) introduced the bipartisan Local Food Recycling and Regenerative Opportunities Act which focuses on reducing food waste by offering tax incentives to households.

The bill would:

- Amend the Internal Revenue Code to provide a 30% tax credit to individuals for expenses related to diverting food waste from landfills.
- Cover costs for qualified residential food recycling appliances (such as in-home dehydrators or food processors that pre-treat waste) and residential organic waste services (such as curbside compost collection).
